Joe started his musical journey in amateur Theatre taking leads in some 40 musicals, dramatic productions and Operas before going to Queensland Conservatorium to study music. After graduating with a Dip Mus. (voice) and a Post Graduate degree in Opera Performance, he returned to Hastings to teach at the E.I.T. for two years, before going freelance as a soloist with most of the opera companies and choral societies throughout the North Island.

After further study Joe took up the position of HOD Music at Karamu High School for 12 years progressing to Head of Performing Arts. While at Karamu, Joe travelled to Auckland on a weekly basis for 12 months to study with Prof. Karyn Grylls at Auckland University.

He has now returned to being a freelance musician, teaching singing and performing solo as well as conducting community based

choirs, high school choirs and Musical Theatre productions. His latest position is Musical Director of the New Zealand Male Choir.

Joe was the popular commentator at the 2018 Regional SingFest.
