

MAY WORKSHOP

The annual NZCF Wellington choral workshop has become a much-loved part of the local choral scene. Singers gather from around the country to rehearse and publicly perform a major work. This year is the 32nd Workshop. The first was conducted by Sir David Willcocks in 1988 and the next seven workshops by Peter Godfrey – and again in 2002. Recent workshops have included Mendelssohn's *Elijah*, Schubert's *Mass in A-flat major*, Haydn's *The Creation*, for the 25th Jubilee, Verdi's, Mozart's and Brahms' *Requiems*, Bizet's *Carmen*, Jenkins' *The Armed Man* Donizetti's *Requiem* and, last year, *Mozart Vespers*.



WHERE AND WHEN?

The event starts on Friday evening 3 May at 7:00pm and continues on Saturday 4 May at 9:30am in the Salvation Army Citadel in Vivian Street. The public performance will be at 7:30pm on Saturday night and we encourage you to invite your music-loving friends and family to attend.

WHO CAN COME?

There are no auditions. All singers are welcome to take this opportunity to sing great works – whether or not you can sight read. If you enjoy choral singing but are unable to commit to regular choir attendance, you will value this chance to immerse yourself in a major choral event.

MUSICAL SCORES

This year printed copies will be provided at registration. We regret that while a limited number of advance choir sets may possibly be available, individual copies CANNOT be provided in advance.

NUMBERS

The maximum number of singers we can accommodate year is about 240. In the event of more enrolments than places, preference will be given to members of New Zealand Choral Federation, Otherwise paid enrolments will be accepted first-come, first-served.
